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I Overview: This course will build on the foundation established in the first level, in the skill areas of reading, speaking, writing and understanding (listening) French. Topical units will be built around interpersonal communication, presentational speaking and writing as well as interpretive activities in reading and listening. Students will be able to sustain a detailed conversation on a variety of topics, asking and responding to questions and making recommendations. Students will be able to understand and follow more detailed conversations of native French speakers. They will be able to understand the main idea of more complicated authentic documents and be able to give presentations on a variety of topics. Various aspects of the Francophone world and French culture are woven into each unit as well.

II Course Objectives:

- Students will develop strategies to become independent language learners
- Students will develop strategies for building vocabulary and discerning authentic texts
- Students will ask and answer information seeking questions
- Students will understand the main idea of authentic texts and be able to listen for detailed information in audio/ video clips.
- Students will be able to write short messages and stories using the future and conditional (as well as past, future and imperative) tenses of verbs.
- Students will be able to give directions and make explanations to help others follow directions.
- Students will be able to make predictions about the future
- Students will be able to use pronouns to make their communication more effective and efficient
- Students will be able to express what would happen if certain circumstances exist
- Students will be able to speak about the weather (present and past)
- Students will compare their own culture to cultures of Francophone countries.
